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Erase the notion that you have to be wealthy to shop at Jack Henry in Los Angeles. While it's true that stars and their stylists are regular clients, everyone is welcome.

"Please don't be scared to make an appointment to come shopping," says owner Tia Browsh, who opened the store five years ago. "It sounds intimidating, but it's not. You don't have to buy anything. I love playing dress-up."

And what a wonderful place to play. Jack Henry carries primarily one-of-a-kind clothing and accessories; Browsh personally scours designers' racks, fashion shows, and other international markets for the clothes, handbags and other accessories she stocks.

Jason Wu, Aurelio Costarella, VPL, Form, Ilo Guarani, Foundation Addict, Chanel, Givenchy—name any terrific classic or up-and-coming designers and you'll likely find their creations at Jack Henry. What you won't find are "trendy" pieces stocked everywhere else. The bottom line: If the piece hits "fabulous" on Browsh's personal fashion meter (think vintage Oleg Cassini gown or Jason Wu one-of-a-kind), she will buy it.

"Usually...I want to buy the things no one else picks out," says Browsh. "But then people come into my store and say, 'Oh my gosh, you have such an amazing store with such unique inventory,' so I guess my gut somehow pulls together a collective of designers and pieces that somehow fits together...."

The store is open to everyone from noon to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, so it's readily accessible.

"Just stop by and look," says Browsh. "I want it to be warm and comfortable. Coming here is about having fun."
